## STEP 1 – ENROLLMENT INFORMATION (MAR 12-24, 2012)

- To ENROLL for Children's Programs, it is required that an annual Enrollment Packet be completed for each child and payment of an annual non-refundable fee (\$55/child or \$80/family) is received. Annual Enrollment Packet and non-refundable fee covers programming from JUN 1 – MAY 31 (including Before & After School Programs for the 2012 – 2013 school year). Enrollment Packets can be downloaded from [www.ifoohills.org](http://www.ifoohills.org) using the School Age Programs & Camps link.

\*NOTE: A complete annual Enrollment Packet includes: *Enrollment Forms (2 pages), Parental Agreement, Immunization Records, Physician Report (for children ages 7 & under) AND Payment.* Administrative Office will accept Physician's Reports up to 1 week prior to the opening of online registration.

- Enrollment Packets must be submitted in person. Enrollments are ONLY accepted at Ridge Recreation Center (6613 S. Ward Street, Littleton, CO 80127) upstairs at the Children's Programs Enrollment Desk.

- Enrollment Packets received after the MARCH 24 enrollment deadline are considered late enrollments and will be assigned a late online registration date.

- \* *Incomplete Enrollment Packets will not be processed and a child's space in programs cannot be guaranteed.*

## STEP 2 – REGISTRATION INFORMATION (APR 2012)

- Register online using the ParentPoint system for specific camps.
- Parents will receive instructions for online registration, including registration dates, user name and password for online system, at the time of enrollment.
- Parents will log on to the ParentPoint system a week prior to the assigned registration dates to ensure user name and password are working properly. If there are problems, contact the Administrative Office at 303-409-2335.
- Parents will log on to the ParentPoint system during their assigned registration dates to register for preferred camp options.
- After parents have registered, they will be placed in a pending status.
- The Children's Programs Administrative Office will manage registration and move parents to an approved enrolled status based on space availability.
- If space is not available in the camp of their choice, parents will be contacted within 72 business hours of registration. (Registrations received after 5 p.m. will be considered as the next business day.)
- The Administrative Office must receive Physician's Reports for Children ages 7 and under at least **1 week prior to the opening of online registration or registrations will be denied.**
- Upon approval of enrollment, a non-refundable deposit of \$25 per week is due within 72 business hours. Deposit price will be deducted from the full weekly price of tuition for that week. Failure to pay the deposit within 72 business hours will result in loss of child's place in program. Parents will be required to register again to determine if space is available.
- Deposits may not be transferred from one week to another week. Deposits may be transferred to a different camp or option in the same week for a change fee of \$10.
- Upon receiving approval of enrolled status, care that week becomes contracted. If cancellation is necessary for that week, parents must cancel the week in writing by the cancellation deadline or parents will be held financially responsible for care for the entire week.

## STEP 3 – PAYMENT INFORMATION

Tuition payments must be submitted prior to care for each camp program. All payments are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month for the upcoming month.

- **AUTOMATIC PAYMENT** is the preferred payment method. Parents/Guardians can choose to have a credit/debit card or bank account automatically charged on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month by submitting the **Auto-Payment Form**.
- **CHECK/MONEY ORDER PAYMENT** is due directly to the Children's Programs Administrative Office (Ridge Recreation Center, 6613 S. Ward Street, Littleton, CO 80127, ATTN: Administrative Specialist) no later than 5 p.m. on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month with a Check/Money Order payment Form (If the 1<sup>st</sup> falls on a weekend, Check/Money Order payments are due to Children's Programs Administrative Office by the last business day prior to the 1<sup>st</sup>.)
- **CHECK/MONEY ORDER PAYMENT** must be made using **Kinderstreet ParentPoint** and are due by **midnight** on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month.
- **LATE PAYMENTS:** All late payments will be assessed a \$35 late payment fee.



# TOTS SPECIALTY CLASSES

Tots Specialty Classes are designed to provide an introduction to a variety of experiences, from cooking to sports and learning activities. Classes are offered on various days during the week to fit your busy summer schedules. A low teacher/child ratio ensures a safe and happy experience for your child. Children need to be toilet trained to register for these classes – the only exception is **Toddlers on the Go (ages 18 – 30 months)**.

*\*Children in I'm a Big Kid Now (ages 2½ – 3½) MUST be toilet trained or accompanied by a parent.*

# ALL DAY CARE • AGES 3 – 5



This full day program operates 6:45 a.m. – 6 p.m. (52 weeks each year). Children are engaged in a developmentally appropriate preschool that is taught with lessons reinforced throughout the day. Stimulating activities are included such as swimming, science, cooking, gross motor, field trips, guest speakers, sign language and gymnastics. Programs are housed in the Lilley Pad Room at Lilley Gulch Recreation Center and in the Little Bear Mountain Room at Ridge Recreation Center. Parents choose the days of the month that care is needed and pay a low daily rate. Our attentive staff provides an environment that is safe and loving for your child to learn, explore, socialize and grow.

**Children ages 3 – 5 are welcome in the program until they begin kindergarten, subject to availability. All children in this program MUST have strong independent toileting skills.**
