This correspondence serves as acknowledgment of receipt of your letter dated May 20, 2009, that was addressed to me and the Foothills Park and Recreation District's Board of Directors. The letter states that certain property owners in the Sixth Avenue area wish to seek exclusion from the District. The letter also suggests the intent to create a win/win solution for all affected parties, and goes on to state that the Mesa View Estates Homeowners' Association wishes to negotiate a price in exchange for title to all Foothills property in the Sixth Avenue Area. Additionally, the letter requests permission for the overlap of special districts and possible contracted management of the pool facility by Foothills Park & Recreation District. I provided a copy of your letter to each of the board members at our board meeting on May 26.

I wanted to take this opportunity to express to you my sadness that any resident of Foothills Park and Recreation District be considering something as drastic as exclusion from our district. I can only imagine that the residents of your Homeowners' Association must be extremely frustrated with something to lead to a decision such as the one outlined in your letter. As you know, I have only been with the District for a little over a year, yet I believe we have taken tremendous strides towards rectifying some of the concerns that you and some of the homeowners in your area may have.

One major improvement that I believe has been made is the provision of accurate and well thought information. In fact, we presented some information to our Board of Directors at their last meeting that outlines the revenues generated from the Sixth Avenue area and the expenditures that are directly spent in your area. I would be happy to provide this information to you if you would like to provide accurate and updated information to the homeowners in your area. In addition, as I have done in the past, I would be willing to meet with you and any others to discuss your areas of concern with Foothills Park & Recreation District.

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
