KINDERGARTEN ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (AFTER MORNING KINDERGARTEN CLASS)

Programs are offered MON-FRI from 11:00am until 3:00pm. Children needing care after 3:00pm can join our After Morning Kindergarten School Program. Program is held at Lilley Gulch Recreation Center. Transportation is provided by our staff from several different schools.

Our programs are designed to serve our community with a safe, fun and enriching childcare environment that includes age-appropriate preschool classes.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Lilley Pad and Little Bear Mountain are open 52 weeks a year MON-FRI • 7:00am-6:00pm (holiday hours may vary). We are closed on the following days:

- Memorial Day • Labor Day • Thanksgiving (THU & FRI)
- Christmas Day • New Year's Day • Staff Development Days.

AGES 2½ to 5 years (until kindergarten)

TOILETING

All children must be toilet trained to attend our programs. Accidents may happen and are handled as discreetly as possible. Extra clothing is kept on site for such accidents and should be washed and returned to the center as soon as possible after use.

STAFF

Our center directors are Large Center Director qualified through the State of Colorado and our preschool teachers are group leader qualified.

SAFETY

Child protection is our priority. Each child in the program is required to wear a name tag. Children must also be signed in and out each day by their parent, guardian or authorized person. Children will only be released to these people and identification will be checked.

SWIMMING

Swimming is offered twice a week throughout the year supervised by our staff and a trained lifeguard.

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Enrichment activities are offered throughout the year, including guest speakers, field trips, cooking and science activities. Children also receive time in the gymnastic facility at Lilley Gulch Recreation Center.

SUMMER PROGRAMMING

During the summer, our programs continue to help your child learn in a "camp" like atmosphere. Even though the days are more relaxed, we provide hands-on learning opportunities for the children each day.

TUITION \$45/day (District Rate: \$40/day)

Tuition is billed monthly and is due by the 25th of each month for the following month. Parents can choose days that care is required each month. We accept drop-in childcare when needed – at a higher fee if space is available.

ENROLLMENT

Enrollment is accepted year-round and depends on availability. An annual non-refundable registration fee of \$55 (\$80 maximum per family) is collected at the time of enrollment. Enrollment forms are due BEFORE your child attends the program and will be given to you when you sign up for the program.

This program is licensed by the state and is staffed by highly qualified Early Childhood Educators. The classes provide children with an outstanding opportunity to advance their physical, social, emotional and cognitive development. All classes feature age appropriate curriculum that allows the students to learn through hands-on experiences. Listed below are the classes currently being offered by Foothills District.

The most important goal of our early childhood curriculum is to help children become enthusiastic learners. We help children become independent, self-confident, inquisitive learners – not just in preschool – but lasting throughout their lives. Parents are requested to volunteer in the classroom, and to provide a snack several times throughout the year.

Preschoolers are placed in a class closest to their peer age group. Children **MUST** be 3 years of age prior to October 1, and they **MUST** be fully toilet trained.

EARLY CHILDHOOD SPECIALTY CLASSES (AGES 6 MO – 6 YEARS)

Early Childhood Specialty Classes are designed to provide an introduction to a variety of experiences. A low teacher-child ratio (8 children to one teacher) and experienced instructors add to the quality of the program. Children must be the specified age by the first day of the session. These classes will be cancelled one week prior to start date if minimum enrollment is not met. TODDLERS ON THE GO! Ages 18-30 months

This parent-participation class is designed to give your child their first classroom experience while learning social and behavioral skills. They learn, grow and share as they create art, music and listen to stories. Non-enrolled siblings may not attend classes, and **ONLY ONE ADULT** per child should remain in their child's classroom.

Fee: \$44 (District Rate: \$35) 4 weeks

SIGN & PLAY Ages 6 months-3yrs

This exciting class teaches sign language communication skills to young hearing children. Proven to improve learning, this also allows them to communicate their needs before they can talk. Classes use music, games, and books in an age-appropriate setting. **PARENTS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND.**

Fee: \$59 (District Rate: \$50) 6 weeks

I'M A BIG KID NOW! Ages 2½-3½

Children enjoy socializing with others as they discover and create in this class. Large and small group time, stories, play time and creative art experiences will provide them with specific age-appropriate skill development. Parents are welcome to stay, but not required. Non-enrolled siblings may not attend classes, and **ONLY ONE ADULT** per child may remain in their child's classroom.

Kids learn about foods, nutrition, manners, and cooking skills in this hands-on class in our kitchen classroom. **CHILDREN MUST BE TOILET TRAINED TO ATTEND THIS CLASS.**
