Park History
The park was acquired in 1972. The park is named after Jim Hoida, a local resident who was active in the local homeowners association and instrumental in the development of the park. The park was dedicated to Mr. Hoida in the early 1990's. Previously, the park was named Lochwood Park. The Lochwood neighborhood never included into the City of Lakewood boundaries. Consequently, the park remained under Foothills jurisdiction after the 1998 Lakewood election that excluded Lakewood from Foothills Park and Recreation District.
